

IN MEMORY AND GRATITUDE Michael A. Clegg, December 4, 1938-April 6, 2021

The Ronald McDonald House Pro-Am is different this year. Not because of COVID-19. Not because of the field. This year, Mike Clegg is not at the tee off, shaking hands and sharing an anecdote. Yet his spirit and relentless drive can still be felt. It is ingrained in the Pro-Am, the committee and the Ronald McDonald House mission.

Mike co-founded the Ronald McDonald House of Cleveland and this premiere fundraising event more than 40 years ago, but never stopped working to make both the best they could be. It became his life's work.

Two years ago at the 40th Annual Pro-Am breakfast, Mike received a standing ovation. He had just finished addressing attendees, sharing the life-altering personal experience that fueled his passion for the House and its mission. As a young father whose 4-year-old son had been diagnosed with acute leukemia. Mike, with his wife Sue, was faced with the challenges of caring for Scotty while trying to keep a sense of normalcy for their other children. He described what it was like to try to remain strong for Scotty and to be among other families struggling as they slept in hospital waiting rooms and ate

from vending machines to be near their sick children. "No parent should have to go through this," Mike thought at that time, and he would spend the next forty years making sure they didn't have to go through it alone.

Mike and Sue's energy and perseverance played an integral role in bringing the first Ronald McDonald House to Ohio, right here in Cleveland. Recognizing the need for ongoing financial support, Mike would use his love of golf and his business savvy to co-found the Pro-Am, which has been the longest-running and most

in which they reported issues: Legal, Family, Advocacy and Finance. Expanded and renamed *Red Treehouse* in 2011, the program has continued to evolve. National, state and local resources are now accessible 24/7 to families in Ohio, Pennsylvania and West Virginia through RedTreehouse.org.

Pro-Am proceeds have helped provide all these services to hundreds of thousands of families over the years. The monies have been used toward building needs, expanded programming and operating costs. The most valuable things the Pro-Am makes possible, however, are intangible: the relief of a family knowing they can stay together and near their sick child, the warmth of a lovingly prepared meal after a long day at the hospital, the understanding of other

successful fundraiser in the non-profit's history. From the first invitation, a mysterious box containing a golf ball mounted on Astroturf promising an exclusive event, through chairing, serving or recruiting others for every Pro-Am committee since, Mike remained a driving force for the golf outing and the mission.

Through the years, Mike helped to grow the House and its programs. He listened to families, especially those whose children had special needs or chronic illnesses, who expressed the difficulties they faced after returning home from their stay at RMH. In response, he helped to launch the *Tools for Today and Tomorrow* program in 2004 to connect families to resources addressing the most common areas

Many things changed for us all during the pandemic. For RMHC Northeast Ohio, finding ways to maintain our meal program was critical to caring for the families staying with us. Serving those meals meant staff needed to innovate and re-imagine our kitchen facilities.

Dining in the kitchen was not an option due to social distancing measures. We pivoted to a room service model, delivering dinners directly to families' rooms. Individually packaged lunches and healthy snacks to-go gave families

safety and convenience—eating at the hospital, in their rooms, or outdoors.

By mid-2020, it was evident that the safety of our guests and sustainability of the meal program demands more permanent changes.

We must redesign kitchens and dining areas in both Akron and Cleveland to accommodate:

- New food-handling safety protocols
- Adequate space for volunteer groups, vital to our program, to prepare meals
- Improved spacing and flow for guest families
